ABOUT

Located at the foothills of the Dandenong Ranges, Melbourne suburb Ferntree Gully has a population of 26,500. The City of Knox suburb situated 30km east of Melbourne's CBD was originally a farming area in the early 1930s and a popular spot for holiday-makers staying overnight is boarding houses and cottages.
